



DRESS CODE POLICY

UWIS has prescribed school uniforms. Our school regards grooming and uniform as basic matters of self-respect and respect for the school community. Students are expected to wear the prescribed school uniform at all times.

Summer/Spring Uniform:

For Girls: Navy blue knee-length skirt, turquoise blue collared short sleeves shirt

For boys: Navy blue trousers, turquoise blue collared short sleeves shirt

Winter/Fall Uniform:

For Girls: Navy blue knee-length skirt, turquoise blue collared long sleeves shirt, navy blue jacket

For boys: Navy blue trousers, turquoise blue collared long sleeves shirt, navy blue jacket

- Students are expected to wear proper school uniforms each and every school day.
- Full school uniforms should be worn on regular school days.
- School uniforms must be clearly visible and not covered by other clothes.
- PE uniforms must be worn only during PE periods.
- Pants may not be baggy or tight fitting such as “skinny pants.”
- Cleats are not acceptable at all times.
- No sandals, boots, clogs, mules, slippers, flip flops, high heels, platform shoes, crocs, or shoes with wheels.
- Girls should have their hair neatly tied back with no loose strands.
- No hats or ice caps are allowed.
- Boys must have clean-shaven faces.
- Boys are expected to keep their hair cut short.
- Nail polish, make-up, and hair coloring are not allowed.
- Nails must be kept short and clean.
- Jewelry, accessories and ostentatious watches are not permitted. Stud earrings (one pair only) for girls are allowed.
- Cleats are not acceptable at all times.
- No sandals, boots, clogs, mules, slippers, flip flops, high heels, platform shoes, crocs, or shoes with wheels.
- Girls should have their hair neatly tied back with no loose strands.
- No hats or ice caps are allowed.
- Boys must have clean-shaven faces.
